### CHRISTIANS ARE DISCIPLES

True followers of Jesus Christ are Christians! We learn from Acts 11:26 that "...the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch." The apostle Paul endeavored to persuade men to be Christians! In Acts 26:28-29 King Agrippa said unto Paul: "Almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian. And Paul said, I would that not only thou. but all that hear me this day, were both almost, and altogether such as I am,..." Peter, who was also an apostle, taught that a man who suffers "as a Christian" should not "be ashamed", but should "glorify God on this behalf." Hear Peter as recorded in 1 Peter 4:16: "Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf."

Let us keep in mind that Christians are disciples! We learn from Acts 14:22 that Paul and Barnabas confirmed "the souls of the disciples" in Lystra, Iconium and Antioch. Referring to the disciples in Troas, Acts 20:7 says: "And upon the first day of the

week, when the disciples come together to break bread, Paul preached unto them..."

A Christian is a disciple! Moses' disciples learned what Moses taught! (See John 9:28). The disciples of John learned what John taught! (See Luke 11:1). We, who are disciples of Christ, are learners! We receive instruction from Jesus Christ as revealed in the New Testament! There are a number of reasons why we should be learners! Here are some of them.

- 1. One must learn in order to go to Christ! Jesus said: "No man can come to me, except the Father... draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day. It is written in the prophets. And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me." (John 6:44-45).
- 2. One must **learn** in order to find rest! (See Mt. 11:28-30)
- 3. One must **learn** in order to be wise unto salvation! (See 2 Timothy 3:15).

# Editorial ...

# SAVING FAITH IS A FAITH THAT OBEYS

We must believe (i.e., have faith) in order to be saved from past sins and also in order to receive eternal salvation! Listen to the Word of God in the following passages.

1. Hebrews 11:6- "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that

diligently seek him."

2. Luke 8:12- "Those by the wayside are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved."

3. Acts 10:43- "...Whosoever believeth in him shall receive the remission of sins." Also see Rom. 1:16; 1 Cor. 1:21: Rom. 5:1; Gal. 3:24; Eph. 2:8-9; 1 John 5:1; John 1:12; Gal. 3:26-27; Acts 15:9; John 3:16; 5:24; 3:36; 6:47; 20:30-31.

4. Mark 16:16- "...But he that believeth not shall be damned." In the book of Romans Paul mentions "...the obedience to the faith..." (1:5) and also "...the obedience of faith." (16:26). We learn from these expressions that "the faith" can (and must be) obeyed

and that one's personal "faith" can (and it must) obey! So, one's personal faith should (and it will if it is genuine) motivate one to obey "the faith" (i.e., the system of faith, the Word of God, the gospel)!

The principle that faith must act in order to avail is set forth by the apostle Paul in Galatian 5:6. As recorded there, Paul declared: "For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth anything, nor uncircumcision, but faith which worketh by love." It is a fact! To avail, faith must work! Not only must faith work, it must work by love!

Let us consider some examples of men who were blessed because of their **faith!** Please observe the fact that the desired result or blessing that came **by faith** ALWAYS came AFTER **faith acted** or **worked!** 

1. Hebrews 11:4- "By faith Abel OFFERED unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous..."

2. Hebrews 11:7- "By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, MOVED with fear, PREPARED AN ARK to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith."

3. Hebrews 11:8- "By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, OBEYED; and WENT OUT, not knowing whither he went."

4. Hebrews 11:9- "By faith he (Abraham) SOJOURNED in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise." Verse 10 says: "For he looked for a city which hath foundations,

whose builder and maker is God."

5. Hebrews 11:17- "By faith Abraham, when he was tried, OFFERED UP Isaac: and he that had received the promises OFFERED UP HIS ONLY BEGOTTEN SON."

6. Hebrews 11:24-26- "By faith Moses, when he was come to years, REFUSED TO BE CALLED the son of Pharoah's daughter, CHOOSING rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season, Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward."

7. Hebrews 11:29- "By faith they PASSED THROUGH THE RED SEA as by dry land: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned."

8. Hebrews 11:30-"By faith the walls of Jericho fell down, AFTER they WERE COMPASSED ABOUT seven days."

NOTE: In every case mentioned above, faith did not stand ALONE! Faith ACTED! Faith WORKED! Faith OBEYED God's will!

SAVING faith will do what God says! In fact, faith does NOT save BEFORE it OBEYS! NOTE: The walls of Jericho fell down by faith AFTER they were compassed about seven days as per God's instructions!

The kind of faith that obeys God comes by hearing the Word of God! (See Romans 10:17). That is why it is absolutely essential that we preach (or teach) "the word of faith" that inspired men in the first century preached! (See Romans 10:8). True faith does NOT come by hearing human traditions, preferences, or emotional feelings!

If faith is **genuine**, it will do WHAT **God says**, in the WAY **God** 

says for the PURPOSE God says! Faith will so act regardless of circumstances or consequences! OBSERVATION: It was the Lord Jesus Christ who plainly declared: "He that believeth and IS BAPTIZED shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned." (Mark 16:16).

Of course, other passages teach that other things are required by the Lord (such as repentance and confession of faith in Christ) in order for a sinner to be saved from his past sins! Then, as a child of God, one must continue to OBEY the Word of God!

Jesus Christ also said: "He that believeth on the Son hath eternal life; but he that OBEYETH NOT the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abideth on him." (John 3:36 Revised Standard Version). NOTE: Where the RSV says "obeyeth not" the King James Version says "believeth not."

The following passages emphasize the fact that one must OBEY God in order to be saved.

- 1. Matthew 7:21- "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that DOETH the will of my Father which is in heaven."
- 2. Hebrews 5:9- "And being made perfect he (the Son -CRS) became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that OBEY him."
- 3. 1 Peter 1:22- Seeing ye have purified your souls in OBEYING the truth..."
- 4. Revelation 22:14- "Blessed are they that DO his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city."

Do you have saving faith? If your faith does not cause you to OBEY the Lord, it is NOT saving faith! (CRS)

- 4. One must **learn** in order to receive faith! (See Romans 10:17).
- 5. One must learn in order to do the will of God! NOTE: One cannot do the will of God unless he learns what that will is! (See Ezra 7:10; John 7:16-17; Phil. 4:9 & Matthew 7:21).
- 6. One must **learn** in order to teach others! (See Matthew 28:19-20 & 2 Timothy 2:2).

To learn the will of Christ in all matters we must listen to ALL that Christ has spoken! (See Acts 3:22-23).

In the last day we will be judged by the words of Jesus Christ! (See John 5:22 & John 12:48).

Are YOU a learner of the will of Christ? If not, then your are NOT a Christian!
