IS MIRACULOUS POWER STILL AVAILABLE FOR THE CHURCH AS IT WAS IN THE FIRST CENTURY?

NO! There is no evidence in the Scriptures nor in the world today that anyone on earth has miracle working power from God as did the apostles and some on whom the apostles laid their hands in the first century. Gifts of the Holy Spirit along with signs, wonders and divers miracles were necessary in the first century for the revelation and confirmation of the Word of God unto man. In John 14:26; 15:26 & 16:7-13 we learn that Jesus promised to send the HOLY SPIRIT Who would teach them all things and bring all things to the remembrance of the apostles; He would guide them "into all truth" and show them "things to come." He promised them power when they received Holy Spirit baptism. We learn from Mk. 16:20 that the apostles "went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following." We also learn from Hebrews 2:3-4 that the purpose of the signs and miracles

was for the **confirmation** of the message given.

Once the **Word of God** was completely **revealed** to inspired men, **confirmed** and given to the world in written form, there would be no further need of miraculous power in the church! (See Gal. 3:15).

OBSERVATIONS:

Although "Jesus Christ (is) the same yesterday, and today, and for ever" (Heb. 13:9), please consider the following.

- 1. He is **not** creating the earth and all things therein as He once did!
- 2. He is **not** turning water into wine as He did in John 2:1-11!
- 3. He is **not** dying on the cross **now** as He did in the first century! Neither is He raising the dead **now**, nor personally walking on the shores of Galilee as He once did, but **Jesus Christ** IS **the same person** NOW **that** He was then!

No, miraculous power is NOT still available for the church as it was in the first century!

Editorial ... SOME THINGS WE ARE NOT ABLE TO DO

As Christians, we should be optimistic. We should keep in mind that "...in tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine or peril, or sword" that we can be "more that conquerers through him that loved us." (Cf. Romans 8: 35-39). We can do "all things" that we are responsible to do! Christ will strengthen us (Cf. Phil 4:13). We should not under estimate God's power and providence! As Paul wrote: "...God is able to make all grace abound toward you: that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work." (2 Cor. 9:8) However, we should not think of men above what is written. (Cf. 1 Cor. 4:6; 2 John 9). There are some things that we are **not** able to do. Here are some of them.

I. WE ARE NOT ABLE TO PERFORM A MIRACLE! Miracles were performed as recorded in the Old Testament. (Cf. Exodus 7:10-13; 7:20-25; Num. 20:7-12; 22:22-35, etc.) Without question, miracles were performed during the personal ministry of Jesus Christ while here on earth. (See John 2:1-11; 5:1-9; 6:1-14; 9:1-7; 11:1-47 & 20:30-31).

Miracles were performed by the apostles and some on whom the apostles laid their hands. (See Mark 16:17-20; Heb. 2:1-4; Acts 5:16; 8:5-6). However, miracles were durational! A study of 1 Cor. 12 will show that miracles were in operation; chapter 13:8-10 shows they were durational and chapter 14 records regulations for those who were performing those miracles! Today, we should "...Believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world." (1 John 4:1). When the searchlight of God's truth is turned on those who claim to be performing miracles, they are found to be false! No, we are **not** able to perform miracles!

II. WE ARE NOT ABLE TO CHANGE EVERYTHING ABOUT US! We cannot add "one cubit" to our stature! Jesus said: "And which of you with taking thought can add to his stature one cubit? If ye then be not able to do that thing which is least, why take ye thought for the rest?" (Luke 12:25-26). NOTE: In this passage Jesus taught against worry!

To illustrate that fact that we cannot change everything about us, I call your attention to a boy that was born with a "birth-mark" on his face. When he started to school he cried about the way his face looked but he could no change it! Years later he retired as president of Princeton University. He had learned to accept what he could not change! Often we try to change the environment or people's attitudes, etc. but we are NOT able to change them! Let us learn to accept (not necessarily approve of them) the things that we are not able to change.

III. WE ARE NOT ABLE TO UNDO WHAT WE HAVE DONE! We may (Continued on page 3)

regret a deed done, a word spoken or an evil thought, but we cannot undo it! We may do it through ignorance, weakness or wilfully, but once done, spoken or thought we cannot undo, unspeak or unthink. If it is sinful we can repent of it, and should, but we cannot undo it! (Cf. Acts 17:30-31; 3:19 & 8:22)

IV. WE ARE NOT ABLE TO FORGIVE SINS ON GOD'S BEHALF! A consideration of the rhetorical question raised by some in the first century suggests that we cannot forgive sins on God's behalf. (See Mark 2:1-12).

We can and should forgive those who sin against us. Jesus said: "...if he repent, forgive him." (Luke 17:3). Paul said: "And be ye kind one to another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you." (Eph. 4:32).

To be forgiven of sins as an alien sinner, one must **repent** and **be baptized** as a **believer** who has **confessed Jesus as Lord.** (See Rom. 10:9-10; Acts 2:38. Also see Acts 8:26-39).

To be forgiven as God's children when we sin we must **repent**, **confess our sins** and **pray**. (See Acts 8:22; 1 John 1:8 & James 5:16).

Regardless of how much we love a person, we **cannot** forgive their sins against God. Only God can do that!

V. WE ARE NOT ABLE TO **CONDITION** OF CHANGE THE THOSE WHO HAVE DIED! Each person has the power of choice. Each one has personal responsibilities. God will hold each one accountable for his actions. Mormons practice what they call "baptism for the dead." Years after a person has died in a lost condition a Mormon will allow another Mormon to "baptize" him on behalf of the dead person in order for the dead person to have his sins forgiven. A consideration of the following passages should convince any truth seeking person that such a doctrine is **false!**

Romans 14:12- "So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God."

Romans 2:6- "Who will render to every man according to his deeds."

2 Corinthians 5:10- "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad."

Although it may be a companion, child, parent or dear friend we cannot change their spiritual condition after they have passed on! They will stand before the Judge of all the earth and give account for themselves! No one can account for another person! Each must stand on his own!

VI. WE ARE NOT ABLE TO OBEY THE GOSPEL FOR OTHERS! Since each individual is personally accountable to God, each individual is personally responsible to obey the gospel of Christ which is God's power to save! (See Mark 16:15-16; Romans 1:16 & 2 Thess. 1:7-9.

I cannot understand, believe, repent, confess and be baptized for someone else. Each one must obey! I can't worship for other! I can't live for others! Each one must worship, serve God and live soberly, righteously and godly.

VII. WÉ ÅRE NOT ÅBLE TO DEVISE A PLAN OF SALVATION! Many have tried and many do try to devise a plan of salvation, but it is impossible! Read Jer. 10:23; Prov. 14:12; Isa. 55:8-9; Rom. 1:22; 1 Cor. 1:18-31 & 3: 18-23.

Let each of us allow God to direct us in and through His Word! Let us have genuine faith and trust in God. Let us praise God, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth." (Rev. 19:6).

Let us not attempt to do those things that we are **not able** to do. Let us strive to teach others **God's Word** and encourage them to fulfill their responsibilities while they are living. Let us take heed unto **God's Word** and **be an example of the believers in both conduct and attitude!**
